Volunteers can choose to give a set number of hours weekly, or to work on a project-by-project basis. Volunteers can work in one area regularly, or in a variety of areas. Volunteering is a chance to share your skills, give back to the community, and meet new friends. (Or volunteer with a friend and work together!)

Some areas in which volunteers are welcome include:

- Set construction or design
- Set painting
- Costume and prop coordination
- Lighting design and hanging
- Grant research and writing
- Marketing and press relations
- Delivery of promotional materials
- Program preparation and design
- Ushering and concession sales
- Event planning and coordination

In general, volunteers should be age 16 or older, although some opportunities exist for younger volunteers.
